## PA & FOH

- Stereo system (preferred: Dynacord Cobra Series, L-Acoustics, Meyer Sound, Turbo Sound, Nexo, D&B or similar) (no Club Series, 100V Systems or DIY!!)
- The System needs to be appropriate to the audience space (105dBA at FOH)
- The 2 Stereo Wireless InEar Monitor Systems are provided by the band.
- Please inform us about the brand and type of the mixing console.
- Digital Mixing Console required: Digit Series (except SD11), Soundcraft Vi Series, Midas M32 or Pro Series (>2c), Behringer X32 and Wing, Yamaha CL Series, A&H Dlive Series.
- The console should be on the latest firmware and must be equipped with WIFI Router.
- Our sound engineer must have the opportunity to install his own snapshot to the console.
- If this is not possible, we provide our own FOH console and stage box. In this case a stable table with at least 1.5x1 meter of surface and a 230V power line must be in place at FOH. Also provide 1x Cat5e cable with ETHERCON connectors from stage to FOH position.
- The mix position (FOH) must be on the centre line of the stage, at least 20 meters away from the stage. There must be no visual obstruction between the stage and the FOH mixing position. The FOH position must not be located in booths, side corridors or under balcony.
- Please do not hesitate to contact our FOH Sound Engineer for any questions, comments or suggestions regarding this Tech Rider.
- 2 Riser (2x1m) are needed for the drums.
- The Organiser is committed to provide an adequate lighting system depending on the stage size. Our light engineer must have the opportunity to operate on the local lighting control desk. A local service technician with knowledge is required to introduce our light engineer. (Preferentially MA Lighting)
- Haze and smoke are a part of the show, please make accommodations to allow this 1 hour in advance and during the show, by switching off fire alarms and detectors.
- Proper protection (security barriers etc.) is necessary fir the FOH!
